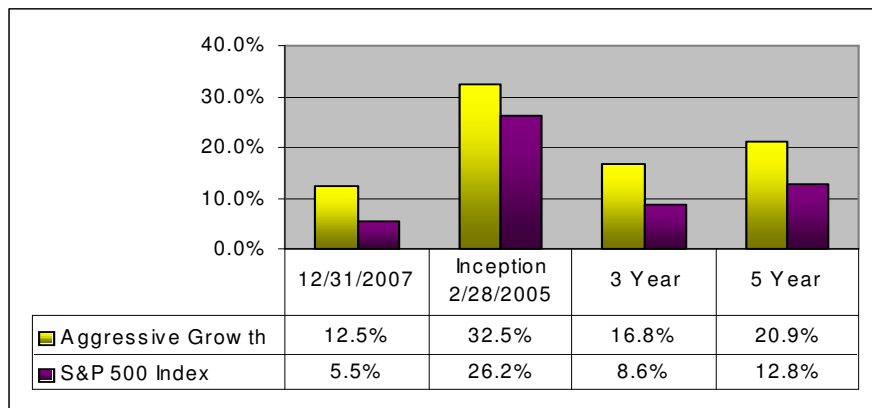

The Aggressive Growth Mutual Fund Portfolio invests primarily in large capitalization growth mutual funds. The portfolio invests in U.S. and internationally markets employing a distinctive economic sector investment strategy. Sectors include, but are not limited to healthcare, energy, natural resources, telecommunication, and technology industries.

The inception return is based on 2/28/2005 to 12/31/2007. The S&P 500 return is for the same periods. The 3 and 5 year returns are hypothetical and based on portfolio model weightings as of 12/31/2007 for each mutual fund within the portfolio. The three and five year returns utilized the category return for two of our current international funds. One fund has less than a three year performance history and both funds have less than a five year performance history. The category returns were 16.8% and 21.6% respectively.
