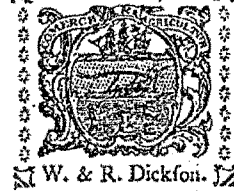

WHEREAS *Malcom M. Intosh* of the Township
of _____ in the County of _____

hath requested to take up *four hundred* Acres of Land

Including an improvement on both sides of the blue knob branch of Poplar run, adjoining Patrick Cassidy, and Jakin Hiram and so extends North Westward to adjoin John Skyran and deep on his line to take in the Hog Camp, and other Springs to the blue knob of Poplar run Situate in Greenfield Township

in the County of *Madison* (Provided the Land is not within the last Purchase made of the Indians) for which he agrees to pay, immediately, into the Office of the Receiver-general, for the Use of this State, at the rate of *fifty Shillings* per hundred Acres, in Gold, Silver, Paper Money of this State, or Certificates; agreeably to an Act of Assembly, passed the first day of April, 1784; and to an Act, passed the third day of April, 1792, entitled, "An Act for the Sale of vacant Lands within this Commonwealth;" and also agreeably to another Act of Assembly, passed the twenty-second September, 1794, entitled, "A Supplement to the Act, entitled, "An Act to prevent the receiving any more Applications, or issuing any more Warrants, except in certain Cases, for Lands within this Commonwealth." Interest to commence from the *1 October 1796*. These are, therefore, to authorise and require you to survey, or cause to be surveyed, unto the said *Malcom M. Intosh* at the Place aforesaid, according to the method of Townships appointed, the said quantity of Acres, if not already surveyed or appropriated; and to make Return thereof into the Secretary's Office, in order for Confirmation; for which this shall be your Warrant.

IN WITNESS whereof, *Thomas M. Mean* GOVERNOR of the said Commonwealth, hath hereunto set his Hand, and caused the Left Seal of the said Commonwealth to be affixed, the *31 August* day of *August* in the Year 18*01*
